**BIZARRE FOODS with Andrew Zimmern**

Andrew Zimmern embarks on an epicurean exploration to reveal the food and stories behind notable characters, cultures and mythology in the new season of Travel Channel's "Bizarre Foods" with Andrew Zimmern. The seven-episode season is a celebration of Zimmern's boundless appetite for culinary history and its cultural impact on a location. From episode to episode, he plunges into the history of the Aztecs in Mexico; traces Napoleon's march through Poland; and examines the folklore behind North America's most storied personalities including Don Juan De Onate, Jesse James and Paul Bunyan. *[Hour-long episodes]*

***"America's First Revolution Trail" - Premieres Tuesday, February 27 at 9 p.m. ET/PT***

Andrew Zimmern explores the route taken by Pueblo leader Po'pay during the 1680 revolt against the Spanish. Along the way, he breaks bread with people who embody the enduring spirit of the Pueblo culture.

***"Aztec Routes of Mexico" - Premieres Tuesday, March 6 at 9 p.m. ET/PT***

Andrew Zimmern explores ancient superfoods, heirloom seeds and indigenous culinary traditions of Aztec Mexico. He eats wild boar with native cactus, stinkbug salsa and seven-chili rabbit before trying sweaty tacos inspired by Aztec ingredients.

Adventurer and explorer Josh Gates returns in an all-new season of the top-rated series, "Expedition Unknown." Gates' insatiable curiosity and appetite for adventure leads him to destinations around the world, uncovering the truth behind more illustrious legends and fascinating lore.
