**PARANORMAL CAUGHT ON CAMERA**

Some of the most amazing, eye-opening and downright scary paranormal videos from around the world are featured as a panel of experts breaks down the footage and analyzes what exactly the eyewitnesses captured. Insights from some of the most knowledgeable specialists in the field and firsthand accounts from the people lucky enough – or perhaps unlucky enough – to witness these strange phenomena for themselves just might make a believer out of even the biggest skeptics out there. *[Hour-long episodes]*

**SERIES PREMIERE: "The Seedy Texas Motel Poltergeist and More" – Premieres Wednesday, February 13 at 10 p.m. ET/PT**

A traveling businessman encounters poltergeist activity in his Texas motel room, a UFO is spotted over one of the holiest sites on earth and a Sasquatch is spotted by two hikers in British Columbia.

Poltergeist activity is caught on an Irish school's security camera, two Russians encounter what may be a Sasquatch while driving in Siberia and a UFO is spotted flying over Australia in broad daylight.

**GHOST ADVENTURES**

In each episode of "Ghost Adventures," Zak Bagans and Aaron Goodwin, along with A/V techs Billy Tolley and Jay Wasley, travel to a different haunted destination where they meet with locals, eyewitnesses and experts in an attempt to piece together the haunted history of each site. They then begin a dusk-to-dawn "lockdown" investigation, using the latest scientific gadgets and technology in an effort to obtain physical evidence of the paranormal and uncover the truth behind each haunted mystery. *[Hour-long episodes]*

**SEASON PREMIERE: "Gates of Hell House" – Premieres Saturday, February 23 at 9 p.m. ET/PT**

The crew is in Las Vegas to investigate intense paranormal activity at The Freakling Bros. Trilogy of Terror, an infamous haunted attraction where employees have reported brushes with a terrifying shadow figure and violent demonic entities.

## NEW EPISODES

### LOST GOLD

Travel Channel's new series, "Lost Gold," follows brothers Josh and Jesse Feldman as they seek out America's most fabled missing treasures. With reverence for the past and a taste for adventure, the brothers track legends and clues across the vast American Frontier in search of unfound riches. To unravel these more than 100-year-old mysteries, Josh and Jesse put themselves in the shoes of the people of the era: they search for old maps, diaries and records, as well as connect with locals who have intimate knowledge of the area. With a family history steeped in lost mines, buried gold and Old West lore, the Arizona natives aren't your typical treasure hunters. Their dogged determination will uncover new leads, fresh perspectives on history and even gold. *[Hour-long episodes]*

#### **"Jim Bowie's Lost Silver Mine" – Premieres Monday, February 11 at 10 p.m. ET/PT**

Josh and Jesse Feldman head to central Texas to explore one of the legendary adventures of Jim Bowie. In 1831, Bowie set out on an expedition to find a lost silver mine but never reached his destination due to a conflict with Native Americans.

#### **SEASON FINALE: "The Lost Blue Bucket Gold" – Premieres Monday, February 18 at 10 p.m. ET/PT**

Josh and Jesse Feldman investigate a remote shortcut off the Oregon Trail connected to a lost wagon train, desperate settlers and a creek filled with gold nuggets. A remote gravesite may point the way to a lost bucket of gold collected by the settlers.

### LEGEND HUNTER

With an avid thirst for adventure and innate curiosity, wildlife biologist and explorer Pat Spain is leaving his lab to uncover answers to fascinating unsolved riddles, historic conundrums and mythic events in the new Travel Channel series, "Legend Hunter." The series showcases Spain as he uses his scientific expertise and state-of-the-art technology to investigate infamous tales of murder, theft and unexplained events. He embarks on a hunt to recover a \$20 million stolen Irish fortune, finds new evidence that could reveal the identity of Jack the Ripper and goes on a quest for a werewolf-like creature rumored to haunt the residents of Elkhorn, Wisconsin. *[Hour-long episodes]*

Host Don Wildman examines a deadly explosion at a nuclear launch site in Arkansas, the incredible story behind a group of legendary fire fighters and a heartbroken ghost who is believed to haunt the house where she once lived.

**SPECIAL: “The Loch Ness Monster Lives: A Mysteries at the Museum Special” - Premieres Wednesday, February 13 at 9 p.m. ET/PT**

Hidden from view, deep in an ancient Scottish lake, is said to be one of the most mysterious creatures in existence – the Loch Ness Monster. Don Wildman goes on a quest to uncover the real story behind this centuries-old mystery and explore a few of the biggest hoaxes associated with the aquatic beast that locals call “Nessie.”

**KINDRED SPIRITS**

In “Kindred Spirits,” premiering its third season on Travel Channel, powerhouse paranormal investigators, Amy Bruni and Adam Berry, enter America's darkest locations demanding answers to the most chilling, haunted mysteries. Amy Bruni and Adam Berry visit Waverly Hills Sanatorium in Louisville, Kentucky. Considered the most haunted location in America, the massive building houses countless spirits, but a dangerous entity on the fourth floor is cause for major concern.

## **FEAR THE WOODS** (U.S. Premiere)

Hiking along pretty tree-lined trails and camping in rustic, ramshackle conditions can be exactly what the doctor ordered, but sometimes the surrounding beauty serves as the perfect camouflage for who – or what – is lurking in the deep, dark woods. In “Fear the Woods,” these haunting and horrific tales of murder and mayhem in the great outdoors are brought to life through emotionally wrought first-person interviews and chilling re-creations. ### **“Terror From the Sky” - Premieres Sunday, February 17 at 9 p.m. ET/PT**

Deer hunters stumble into the territory of a legendary – and very angry – beast. Two friends on a cross-country road trip get into big trouble when they happen to tell a creepy local where they will be camping that night.
