BELIEVERS

Paranormal tales are often dismissed as fiction, but for many who've faced the unknown, these tales are all too real to relive. Now, through actor portrayals, archival documentation and dramatic re-creations, the terrifyingly true events that transformed these unsuspecting eyewitnesses into believers are pieced together. *[Hour-long episodes]*

SERIES PREMIERE: "The Slip Knot" – Premieres Saturday, July 11 at 9 p.m. ET/PT

A Hollywood photographer is choked by the spirit of an angry sailor, an apparition lures a security guard to the scene of a deadly fire and a police detective discovers a missing woman, seen by a passerby, is actually dead.

"Nervous Wreck" – Premieres Saturday, July 18 at 9 p.m. ET/PT

A wrecking yard owner is shocked to see a ghost on a security camera, a retired schoolteacher's wife is attacked by a vengeful spirit and a mother and son search for a paranormal voice captured on a chilling audio file.

SERIES PREMIERE: "Paranormal Predator" – Premieres Saturday, July 11 at 10 p.m. ET/PT

A travelling salesman checks into a motel where he documents poltergeist activity with his cell phone. Fleeing into the night, he becomes possessed by the spirit of a murderer and in need of an exorcism. While on a school trip to the Vatican, a teenager and his friends accidentally set free an ancient evil and suffer the consequences. Then, a journalist is hunting down a story in Connecticut, when she checks into a historic New England inn and fights off a supernatural attack. These guests have all become prey to a paranormal predator.

"A Dark History" – Premieres Saturday, July 18 at 10 p.m. ET/PT

Supernatural events compel a hotel owner to dig up buried secrets, a chef is terrorized by a ghostly lady in red and a young boy is menaced by a dark apparition at a luxury hotel.
