“Lois & Clark: The New Adventures of Superman” (Hub TV Premiere, 3 back-to-back episodes every Sunday this summer, 8-11 p.m.)

The live-action series features the daring exploits of the legendary Superman in an exciting, action-packed, hour-long series featuring iconic comic book characters Clark Kent (Dean Cain, “Las Vegas”), his superhuman alter ego and Lois Lane (Teri Hatcher, “Desperate Housewives”) in the most unrequited romance of all time. **Rating: TV-PG**
